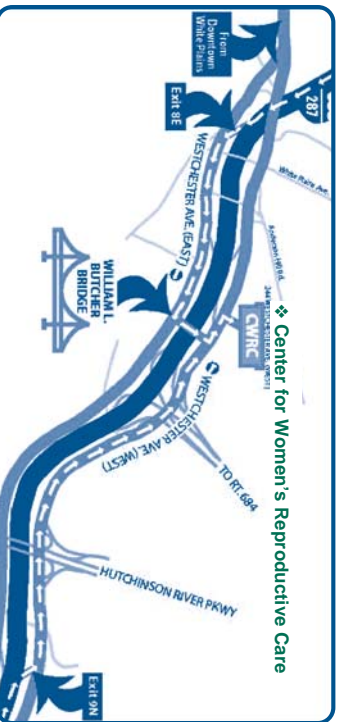

- Take I-287W to Exit 9N onto Westchester Avenue West.

THE CENTER FOR WOMEN'S REPRODUCTIVE CARE

The *Center for Women's Reproductive Care (CWRC) at Columbia University* is a subspecialty practice staffed by full-time faculty of Columbia University. The Center offers: fertility assessment, IVF, egg donation, male infertility care, PGD (pre-implantation genetic diagnosis), egg and embryo cryopreservation (freezing and storage) and other advanced treatments.

One of the hallmarks of the Center is the ability to make the most innovative, cutting-edge research and fertility treatments available to a wide population of patients through affordable, accessible care. Expanded access takes place at many levels:

Clinical: by specializing in challenging cases (accepting patients despite poor prognosis profiles);

Financial: through our in-network managed care contracts (which minimize our out-of-pocket expenses), patient financing options, and financial support through the NYS Infertility Demonstration Program grant.

Geographic: services offered in two conveniently located facilities; on Columbus Circle, in the heart of Manhattan, and in White Plains.

AVAILABLE SERVICES

Fertility Assessment: An initial consultation determines whether prospective patients can benefit from subspecialty services and treatments.

IVF: Fertilization of eggs occurs in a laboratory setting; once the embryo is formed, it is placed back into the patient's uterus to establish a pregnancy.

Donor Egg (No Waiting List): Available highly qualified prescreened egg donors has given our patients remarkably high pregnancy rates in a completely anonymous fashion and without inordinate delays.

Male Infertility: Our andrology division includes: semen analysis, antisperm antibodies tests, Y-chromosome microdeletion tests, intrauterine insemination and ICSI (Intracytoplasmic sperm injection) services.

PGD (Preimplantation Genetic Diagnostic): A biopsy of an embryo for genetic diagnosis purposes. May be used for aneuploidy screening as well as detecting many single gene disorders prior to embryos being transferred.

Endoscopic Surgery: Through the use of an endoscope, a surgeon can view images of the body's internal structures via very small incisions. This technique is also known as minimally invasive surgery.

Patient Fertility Educational Workshops: Weekly sessions on various fertility topics are led by our doctors and other qualified professionals.

Other Support Services are available, such as psychological support. Our social workers and staff psychiatrists help patients deal with the emotional aspects of treatment, and facilitate their experience as patients during treatment.

PAYING FOR FERTILITY CARE

- Our In-Network managed care contracts minimize patient's out-of-pocket expenses.

Insurances accepted (All in-network): Aetna/US HealthCare, Cigna, Empire Blue Cross Blue Shield, GHI, Healthnet, HIP, Oxford, POMCO, Unicare, and United Healthcare.

- **One-time Introductory Reduced Fee:** please visit our website for current rates and qualifying restrictions.
- **Patient financing** is also available through an outside finance company.
- **Partial medication** subsidies may occasionally be available through select pharmaceutical companies based on patient economic need.

IVF COVERAGE? NO. WE CAN HELP!

Our Center participates in the **New York State Department of Health Infertility Demonstration Program** grant for the underinsured.

Under this program individuals with insurance but without full infertility coverage (including In Vitro Fertilization – IVF) can obtain financial support on a sliding scale of household income for an IVF cycle. Patients must meet certain criteria including New York State Residency, be between the ages of 21-44, be clinically infertile as well as other clinical and program criteria.
